Minutes of the National Board of Directors Regular Meeting Mustang Club of America Dallas, Texas November 14, 2009

The Minutes from the September meeting were approved as submitted.

The President started the meeting with a welcome statement, thanking all on the BOD for their work over the past year. He also identified all of the BOD that are leaving as of the end of the year. He invited all to attend the annual BOD meeting in Phoenix with a visit to the Barrett-Jackson auction on Saturday.

Executive Committee Report:

The Chair; Mr. McCarley, briefly discussed the items discussed by the Executive Committee in their teleconferences since the last BOD meeting, focusing upon the upcoming number of meetings in 2010, finances, and the status of the PDMG/PMG contracts (PMG contract proposal withdrawn). In addition, the ExCom discussed financing for the National Shows, approved going forward with mass e-mailings beginning in 2010, and the status of 2009 funds from Ford, which have not yet been received.

35th Anniversary Show:

Discussion was held as to possible locations for the event, including Las Vegas, Barber Motorsports, Charlotte, NC, and distributing the anniversary throughout all of the National Shows. A committee will be formed for a recommendation to be voted upon at the January meeting.

Annual Meeting:

The 2010 Annual Meeting will be held in Phoenix, AZ at the Airport Marriott Hotel, Jan. 22-24. Friday afternoon (1-5PM) will be Orientation, with that evening free. Saturday will be spent at Barrett-Jackson (MCA has passes), but the pre-dinner Meet/Eat will begin at 6, with dinner at 7PM. A guest speaker is being arranged for later that evening. Sunday (9-4PM) will be the BOD meeting.

2010 Meetings:

The rest of the 2010 meetings will be held in Dallas, TX on April 10, July 10, and Oct. 9.

2010 Elections

L. Bragg presented the results of the 2010 elections, with a total of 862 MCA members casting votes. The following individuals have agreed to serve on the 2010 BOD: C. Chesley, R. Cunningham, J. Dettori, J. Farmer, B. Frender, B. Henson, T. Hernquist, J. Keenan, K. Lawrence, P. Sigwardt, L. Slawson, and G. Valeri.

Finance Committee Report:

R. Bramlett presented the 2009 balance sheet as of the end of September. He also presented the draft 2010 budget, which will be formally voted upon at the January meeting.

Membership Report:

R. Orr presented the MCA membership as of September as 11,305, and for October as 11,254.

Unfinished Business

Driving Event Report and Motions:

Four driving event applications have been received: two at Nashville by the Music City Mustang Club, one for Kershaw, S. Carolina hosted by the Carolina Regional Mustang Club, and an event at Little Talladega Grand Prix by the Georgia Regional Mustang Club. A motion was made to approve these four applications by the Committee, and was approved by the BOD.

A motion was made by the Committee that applications for driving events shall be submitted to MCA at least 6 months in advance of the event. The motion was passed.

A motion was made by the Committee that the MCA Driving Guidelines/Applications be altered to reflect a loan of up to \$2500 only to the first time for any one club and that no stipend shall be made available. This motion was passed by the BOD.

The meeting was placed in Recess at 12:00 PM for lunch The Chair called the Meeting back to Order at 1:00

National Show Guidelines

R. Jacobson made a motion to accept the latest version of the National Show Guidelines as submitted to the BOD. The motion was seconded and approved.

Committee Reports

Event Development

The committee discussed the current status for 2011 National Shows. The North Texas National Show in April was previously approved. Two applications have been received for National Shows in 2011; Jacksonville, FL. in May, and Des Moines, IA. in June, but each have issues. The National Capital Club has expressed interest in holding a show in either 2011 or 2012. The Columbus, OH club would like to host a Grand National in the future. Lincoln, NE is interested in hosting a show in 2012 or 2013.

Insurance

The Committee believes it would be best to reduce the number of static shows for insurance from 160 to 150, as there were only 131 shows in 2009 that requested insurance. This would save MCA approximately \$1000. The number of driving events to be supported will remain at 12.

The Committee expressed feedback as to whether to pursue an insurance policy for Internet activity. The feedback provided by the BOD was to find more information, particularly cost.

Internet Committee

R. Jacobson added to his submitted report that the Travel links for MCA have been deleted, as the vendor is no longer supplying that service.

Regional Club Charter Committee

The Committee made a motion to grant a charter to the Mustang Club of St. Louis. The motion passed.

The Committee made a motion to grant a charter to the Wild Horse Mustang Club in Texas. The motion passed.

The Committee made a motion to charter the Steel Horse Mustang club in Redding, PA. The motion passed.

The Committee made a motion to charter the Black Swamp Mustangs in Delphus, OH. The motion passed.

New Business

Submitted by:

Friends of MCA. A. Craig discussed the background for a promotion for businesses and/or associations to have their names listed in Mustang Times, similar to that in the NorCal SAAC newsletter. A simple listing was anticipated. He will provide more details in the December issue of Mustang Times. B. Johnson made a motion that the BOD authorize Friends of MCA as an active promotional program. The motion was seconded and approved.

Regional Club Tiering. R. Jacobson discussed the idea of providing some sort of tiered recognition for the MCA Regional Clubs, based upon (for example), percentage of MCA memberships, level of activity, etc. Discussion by the BOD elucidated the pro's and con's, including nurturing the involvement of the Regional Directors. No action was taken.

New Contracts. R. Jacobson discussed the idea that all contracts above a certain amount (\$10k?) should be competitively bid by a Request For Proposal process, and that all existing contracts be re-competed after a certain number of years. The idea was received favorably, but it was requested that a short summary in writing be presented to the BOD at the January meeting for a possible vote at that time.

Mustang Times Concerns. C. Hampton, based upon feedback from MCA members, that the magazine seems to have lost its focus upon MCA member's cars and submissions, and that corporate-led articles are gaining in content. While a balance is needed between all submissions, that balance may need reexamination.

- All MCA rule requests must first be reviewed by or referred to the Bylaws Committee, before they can be voted on as to have them reviewed from a legal and Parliamentary standpoint.
- 2 Regional Directors and Guests shall sign in at National meetings.
- Four months prior notice is required for changing a Board of Director's meeting, except in cases of extreme circumstances due to weather or a catastrophic event.
- 4 All committees shall submit written reports prior to the meeting when possible.
- 5 The Financial report as reported by the Treasurer at an MCA Board Meeting shall be displayed on the website as soon as possible, once the minutes are officially approved.
- The Secretary's draft of the previous meeting shall be e-mailed to the National BOD as soon as possible for corrections, and when officially approved, a summary of the minutes will be displayed online as soon as possible with notification of such in *Mustang Times*.
- All contracts exceeding \$10,000 to first be reviewed by legal counsel prior to being awarded.
- 8 When an MCA member sends a mass e-mail to the Board of Directors, the President or Vice President will notify the Board as to who shall be the responder to ensure the individual receives a timely response from the correct BOD member or committee head.
- All committees and custody holders of MCA must submit committee notes and completed projects and copies of software to the MCA Office for filing in December, so future members will have some background and history to use as a guide. (every three to five years files will be purged to Historian for record keeping)

We feel that clubs who have hosted a prior event should be financially stable enough to not need any financial assistance beyond year one. Also, we feel that, for budgeting and insurance allocation purposes, we need the six month rule.

MOTION

The Driving Events Committee would like to see the following changes made to the existing rules for hosting an MCA Sanctioned Driving Event:

- 1.All event applications must be submitted at least 6 months prior to the event date, and in the calendar year prior to the event.
- 2. The loan amount for Driving Events be lowered to \$2500.00, and be available for first-time events ONLY.

We have applications for 4 driving events for 2010

The first is for Music City Mustang Club open track event may 28-29 Nashville SuperSpeedway.

The second is for Carolina Regional Mustang driving school June 5-6-7 @ Carolina Motor Sports Park, Kershaw, SC with a \$2500 loan request

The 3rd is Georgia Regional Mustang Club June 2010 At Little Talledga Grand Prix. The 4th is for September 17-18,2010 Nashville; same set up as their may event.

Now we feel the rules need changing some what to ensure a timely procedure.

We want a minimum time between application and the date. We have had problems with applications coming in 1 month to 1 week before the event. This puts a strain on every one. It also reflects in the organization of the event. If you wait to the last minute to get in an application then we feel the quality of the event is suspect.

We feel that the loan provision (currently \$5000) needs to be changed. We feel a \$2500 one time loan to first time applicants only. This is to be approved only after a budget has been submitted and reviewed to show a legitimate need.

Also we need to remove the \$300 stipend currently in the rules. This was a idea that was added to help get this started and now it is not necessary and seldom asked for.

For the future, think about it that it may be possible to start charging clubs for insurance. (1-3 year time span) We cannot make too many changes at once but he idea is to get driving events self-sustaining.

Final statement, we feel that our driving events are growing in stature as national shows and we respectfully request more Mustang Times support to better show how MCA is branching out and reaching new members. Having members of the executive committee at the event would be a big help.

Finance Committee Report

There are 3 major things that the Finance Committee has worked on since the September BOD Meeting in Dallas; the Pate Marketing Group Contract (PMG), the Publishers Data Management Group Contract (PDMG) and the 2010 MCA Budget.

- 1.) Regarding the Pate Contract, the Finance Committee met by teleconference and by e-mails to confer on the Pate contract after receiving the finial revised contract back from Pete Roberts, the MCA attorney. We spent several hours going over the contract and trying to fully understand exactly what was written in the contract and how it would affect the MCA. In the end, we all agreed that since the it was written into the contract that PMG would only use the MCA's membership list to recruit and to keep MCA members and not be required to do any other outside promotion of the MCA, it would not be wise to spend \$3,000.00 to \$4,000.00 per month in this way. Therefore, we made the recommendation to the Executive Committee and President Steven McCarley not to sign the contract. However, before the Executive Committee could come to a decision, the contract was revoked by Pate. I am not entirely sure of the reason however I do know that the MCA has a very good relationship with Pate concerning Mustang Times and I'm sure both of us do not want to enter into any contract that we don't both understand or have misconceptions about. To date, there are no plans that the Finance Committee is aware of for Pate to submit a revised contract although it may be a possibility in the future.
- 2.) Since the MCA is not moving forward with the Pate contract, the Finance Committee did not feel it was in our best interest, at this time, to extend or expand on the PDMG contract without more thought and impute from others in the club such as the MCA Office Manager, Kristie. We are looking forward in the near future to talking to Kristie and seeing how this contract would benefit the MCA and her job. So far, it's still in the works and PDMG has been very patient with us on it. More at the January BOD meeting.
- 3.) The MCA 2010 budget has been gone over by the Finance Committee several times and will be ready to present at the November, 2009 BOD meeting for approval. All of the Finance Committee members have worked hard on it but one person, Jim Chism, has been the one who has put the most time in. Jim will not be returning to the MCA BOD in 2010 so let's all thank him for his hard work when we next see him.
