MCA Show Requirements

By signing the Registration, you acknowledge the receipt and understanding of these show requirements.

Judges Meetings - Held Friday and Saturday at 10:00 am

- 1. Fire Extinguisher is required to enter the show. It should always be available but not on display where it can be run over or kicked.
- 2. All cars must remain in place during show hours unless released by, Host Club Show Chairman, and MCA Head Judge. Show hours are:

Friday & Saturday

8:00 am to 5:00 pm

Sunday

8:00 am until the end of awards presentation

- 3. Once a car is parked only the Host Club Show Chairman and MCA Head judge may grant permission for the car to move or start its engine.
- 4. Entries that move or leave before the end of show hours without permission as required by item 2 or are not back in place on time are subject to disqualification by the MCA Head Judge, unless released due to weather or unexpected events by the MCA Head Judge and Host Show Chairman.

Friday and Saturday the car should stay in place once given a designated parking location. Sunday it should be in place by 10:00 am if judging has been completed. *

- 5. Class changes can only be made by either the MCA Head Judge(s) or Assistant National Head Judge for Classification.
- 6. All hoods, deck lids, windows and convertible tops must be up.

Division VI -Daily Driven hoods must be closed. (On some modified convertible cars, the tops may not be available. Determination will be made at classification if no top up will be acceptable without losing points)

- 7. No displays except Thoroughbred & Modified Classes (ME, MF, MG & MX).
- 8. No pop up tents, umbrellas, or other objects that can be blown around by the wind are allowed for car show participants. Folding chairs should be secured when not in use. No drones over the show field.
- 9. Permission to move a car for photo shoots can only be given by the MCA Head Judge.
