Our standards of ethics demand honesty and fairness in dealing with members, associates, vendors and fellow Board members.

All Officers and National Directors shall observe:

- The By Laws of the MUSTANG CLUB OF AMERICA
- Financial honesty in submitting expenses
- Confidentiality
- Sharing of information and responsibilities with Committee members and BOD
- Represent all members and Regional Groups with fairness, regardless of geography or type of involvement with Mustangs
- Attend every scheduled or specially called Board meeting
- Notify the President and Secretary if attendance at a Board meeting is not possible
