

## UNRESTORED MUSTANG RULES

Unrestored cars are usually low mileage with original factory parts and equipment as ordered. These cars will be judged on originality by **authenticity standards** with reproduction or updated Ford Service Replacement parts not acceptable. Quality and condition will be judged as unrestored, not restored cars. Small imperfections in the paint, undercarriage surface, rust, etc. should be considered normal for unrestored cars. Major dents, body rust, and torn upholstery are not considered normal wear.

It should be noted that some features on certain early and late production cars will vary from the norm and will be judged accordingly.

<b>D. Interior:</b>	
Carpet Replaced.....	25
Seat covers Replaced .....	25
Door panels Replaced .....	25
<b>E. Trunk:</b>	
Trunk mat Replaced .....	25
Jack Assembly Replaced.....	25
<b>F. Original Undercarriage.....</b>	<b>25</b>
Safety items can be replaced with correct original parts with no point deduction. Also exhaust may be replaced as long as correct original parts are used.

### Platinum Award

The Unrestored Mustang is considered to be of historical value and one that can be referred to by other Mustang enthusiasts desiring to restore their Mustang to Concours original. To recognize Unrestored Mustang owners who have conserved their original Mustang to the highest degree possible, MCA will honor those individuals with a Platinum Award. This relatively new award, initially beginning in 2005, will be given at Grand National Shows only.

Requirements for the Unrestored Platinum award (**Both** 1 & 2 below must be satisfied):

1. **Gold Award** (Not including Bonus Points)  
1964 ½ - 1978: Must score a Gold Award (95% or -25 points)  
1979 - **2004**: Must score a Gold Award (96% or -20 points)
2. **Gold Award** (Including Bonus Points which will be factored in)  
1964 ½ - 1978: Must score 98% of **total** points (-10)  
1979 - **2004**: Must score 99% of **total** points (-5)
